Travel information

Travelling to Rabat

The Rabat-Sale international airport is 30 min from the capital of Rabat. There is good air connection between Rabat and other major international airports. Further information on airport website: <http://www.onda.ma>

How to get to Rabat?

To get to Rabat from the Airport, we kindly suggest you to take a Grand Taxi. There are taxies available in front of the Airport building. Since Rabat Airport is fairly small you will easily see the taxies waiting in front of the arrivals gate. The cost of taxi drive to Rabat is per the number of kilometres (3 kilos => 23MAD/ 2 Euros/ 2.5 Dollars).

The organising committee will provide a shuttle from the airport to Rabat if a group of participants are arriving on the same day. Further details will be provided via email. (Committee email).

Travelling to Casablanca

Mohammed V International Airport is an international airport serving Casablanca. There are more than 30 airlines with routes to/from the airport with nearly 100 destinations. Further information on airport website: <https://www.casablanca-airport.com>

How to get to Rabat from Mohamed V airport?

To get to Rabat from Mohamed V airport, we suggest you take the train. There is a train every hour. The station is located in the basement (arrivals) of terminal 1. The cost of a 1st class ticket is 133 MAD (approximately 14.30\$) as for the 2nd class; it is 80 MAD (8.50\$). The trains go to Casa Port train station and from there you will take your connecting train to Rabat from another platform.

Public transportation in Rabat

The Rabat-Salé tramway system is an excellent way to get around in Rabat. Fares are 6 MAD (0.64 \$). The tickets are bought from ticket machines on the platform. The services run from 6am to 10 pm.

Buses are not recommended, as the numbering system is complicated.

Taxi

Petit taxi, all blue in colour mostly Fiat Uno or Dacia, is a better way to get around in Rabat. Cost of taxi is approximately 7 to 15 MAD (2 \$). The price per kilometre is 1.60 MAD but it is increased by 50 % at night. Most of the taxis do not accept payments by card.

The taxi fares may slightly vary depending on the traffic. Please note that most of the taxis accept only cash payments, therefore you should change some money in advance, or do it at the currency exchange points (there are exchange points at the airport).
